14 **AFFIDAVIT FOR RETURN OF
15 UNLAWFULLY SEIZED PROPERTY
16 ON CONSTITUTIONAL GROUNDS**

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19 ON CONSTITUTIONAL GROUNDS**

20 Pursuant to Fed. R. Crim. Proc. 41(g), “[a Natural] person aggrieved by an unlawful
21 search and seizure of property or by the deprivation of property may move for the
22 property’s return.”

23 Fed. R. Crim. Proc. 41(g) falls within equitable authority justice designed to
24 supplement the common law by taking action in a reasonable and fair manner which
results in just outcome for achieving natural justice where one is allowed to enforce his/her
constitutional rights.

1 Eighth Amendment Excessive Fines clause prohibits disproportionate forfeitures of
2 property. In *Waters-Pierce Oil Co. v. Texas*, 212 U.S. 86 (1909), the Supreme Court held
3 that excessive fines are those which are "so grossly excessive as to amount to a deprivation
4 of property without due process of law." A true and correct copy of the unauthorized use of
5 private conveyance demand letter is incorporated herein as reference (*EXHIBIT "A"*)
6 Nassor Mooruts Bey shows the court the following:

7 Owner, Nassor Mooruts Bey is entitled to lawful possession of the seized property;
8 Black 2001 Ford Ranger Truck VIN# [REDACTED], his Moorish American
9 Allodial Nationality and Identification Card, his Moors Heritage and History School Card,
10 and Constitutional Right to Travel Mode Card, and Aboriginal/Indigenous tag affixed
11 without damage (2) this property was never contraband; and (3) the seizure was unlawful.

12 May 5, 2015 a NOTICE OF NOLLE PROSEQUI was file by MARK A. OBER d/b/a
13 STATE ATTORNEY with in the Circuit Court of The Thirteenth Judicial Circuit of the
14 state of Florida in and for Hillsborough county criminal justice division 2015-CF-003148.
15 Due process rights are further being violated by the people d/b/a government to continue
16 the possession of my property.

18 WHEREFORE Nassor Mooruts Bey demands immediate release of the 2001 Ford Ranger
19 Truck, and Moorish American Allodial Nationality and Identification Card, his Moors
20 Heritage and History School Card, and Constitutional Right to Travel Mode Card to be
21 delivered undamaged to location: c/o 18790 United States Highway 301 South
22 Wimauma, Florida zip exempt [33598]
